## Mission Statement | worksheet

Don't forget that you have been given all the resources you need in Christ for living the Great Commission in the everyday! The whole purpose of God's rescue of you is so that you no longer have to live for the lesser purposes of comfort, control, and the dreams of your old citizenship. You've been rescued from that for a much greater Story and purpose - to be ambassadors of the Kingdom, putting God's grace and truth on display among the community.

Take what you've been learning over the last few weeks and consider what it means for you to live from the power of the gospel for the purpose of the gospel, to draw on the resources of Christ to live as a disciple-maker for Christ. (If you are married, do this together with your spouse and consider how this affects your family together).

## Putting it together into a mission statement.

Start with a "because" statement that sums up all that is yours in and through Jesus' work on your behalf, and end it with a "I will" statement that summarises what you want your life to be about. It can be as short and simple as you'd like, but try to make it both concise and comprehensive. Here are a few EXAMPLES:

- Because Jesus is my King and Saviour, I will shape my life around his heart to see those distant to him, experience him.
- Because the Father rescued me by grace through Jesus, I will surrender my whole life to the purpose of helping others know and live in this grace with me.
